### Report

The Departments of Hindi of MES Asmabi College and Sree Krishna College, Guruvayur, jointly organized a **National Webinar on the topic “Premchand ke Katha Sahitya Mein Yatharth Chitran”** on **2nd August 2025**. The event brought together scholars, students, and literature enthusiasts from across the country to explore the themes of realism and social reflection in the works of the legendary Hindi writer Munshi Premchand.

The session commenced with a warm **welcome address by Dr. Surya Boss**, HOD of Hindi, Sreekrishna College, Guruvayur who set the tone for the webinar by emphasizing the continued relevance of Premchand's literary contributions in today's socio-cultural context.

The webinar was well-received and served as an enriching academic experience, underlining the timeless relevance of Premchand's work and the continued need to reflect on realism in literature.





## Participant Feedback
